 - *"And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock? And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts [also]"* (**Numbers 20:10-11**)
 - The _____ Sin - *"Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock?"*
 - What's the sin? *"They angered [him] also at the waters of strife, so that it went ____ with Moses for their sakes: Because they provoked his spirit, so that he spake _____ with his lips"* (**Psalms 106:32-33**)
 - The surface sin was... Moses expressed his _____.
 - *"And Moses lifted up his hand, and with _____ rod he smote the rock twice"* (**Numbers 20:11**). It wasn't the rod that God had told him to bring... It wasn't Aaron's Rod that signified God's power and authority... It was Moses' own rod... signifying his own authority.
 - *The main issue is for the congregation to see what _____ is going to do.*

- **CONCLUSION**
 - Did you know... that God loved to show the Hebrews... pictures... types... symbols... of His Son... Jesus Christ?
 - The Passover Lamb was a picture of Jesus Christ. The blood that was shed and applied on the door... was a picture of Christ. The lamb's blood didn't take away sin... it just picture Christ's blood.
 - When they came upon the bitter waters... and God instructed Moses to throw in the tree... and it became sweet: that was a picture... of the cross of Christ.
 - If you remember the first time Israel saw water gushing from the rock while they were at Horeb... I pointed out that that rock was a picture of Christ. The water that gushed out was but a picture of the Living Water. *"Drink of Me... and you'll never thirst again!"*
 - Manna was a picture of Jesus Christ. He is the "Bread of Life"!
 - The tabernacle was nothing but a picture of Jesus Christ.
 - Aaron's rod... was a type of Christ. That rod was just a dead stick... until the power of God was applied to it. From something that was dead... God could bring forth life. God used Aaron's Rod to picture His Son Jesus Christ. To picture His dead... burial... and resurrection.
 - Moses was to take the *"Budding Rod of Aaron"* and _____ to the rock.
 - *"Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; And did all eat the same spiritual meat; And did all drink the same*

spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ" (1 Corinthians 10:1-4).
