The best way to show the Lord that you love Him is through your _____ (John 14:15).

Big Idea: _____ Him Because You _____ Him!

- **Who does this apply to?**
 - _____ – He has called us to perfection but into His redemption and live it out
- **Why does this apply to Believers?**
 - You have been _____ with His blood on Calvary's tree. That means you are not your _____ (1 Cor. 6:19-20; Acts 20:28; Eph. 1:14; Gal. 3:13; 1 Peter 1:18-19; Rev. 5:9).
 - You are now an epistle (a letter or a Bible) that somebody else will read (will see on display) (2 Cor. 3:2-3).
- **What does this mean for me as a believer and what does this look like?**
 - My life is not my _____. I'm going to steward my life as if He were to live as me.
 - The Bible tells us in **Psalm 24:1** that the earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof. It all belongs to Him. *A steward simply means a manager* (1 Cor. 4:1-2).
 - Areas to Steward:
 - _____ – *speech*
 - _____ – *lifestyle*
 - _____ – *compassionate for others*
 - _____ – *our spirits must cooperate with God's Spirit.*
 - _____ – *convictions (in what you believe) were to be exemplary*
 - _____ – *to be exemplary morally, mentally, and physically (holiness)*
 - In essence, we are to live a life that is consistent. Jesus said either to believe His words or His works (**John 10:37-38; 14:11-12**). They both lined. Ours should be the same!

 - The day you _____ Christ is the day you start. You now are his representative (2 Cor. 5:19-20). You are taking Jesus to every place you and to every person you meet.
