Eph. 1:15-23

When the church prays for _____, she taps into her powerful and spiritual resource – the Lord Jesus Christ.

A blueprint for the church to follow, we should learn to _____ for one another because of the lessons we must learn!

The possibilities are endless if you want to know more about Christ. He hasn't hidden himself from his children, because He wants to reveal himself to us through His Word and prayer. Here is a blueprint for us to now today – we should know more about Christ because of the impact from prayer!

- **Impact of the _____ of Christ**

- God is the Source of our Spiritual Blessings, and He is the Father of glory in our text. Jesus Christ has provided our Spiritual Blessings, and he is described the Lord of glory (1 Cor. 2:8). Spirit Bestows us our Spiritual Blessings, because God the Holy Spirit is the revealer of glory (Read 1 Cor. 2:9-11).
- Wisdom according to Webster's 1828 dictionary means the _____ or exercise of _____.
- Revelation means laying bare, making naked; a disclosure of _____, instruction; manifestation, appearance.
- A person can only be known through a process of revelation that is going to _____ some facts about them.
- God has revealed Himself to us two ways – the _____ Word and the _____ Word. He has said what He is like in the one, and He has shown what He is like in the other. What did He say He was like?
 - (Gen. 1:1; Exodus 3:14; Psalm 116:5; Psalm 145:8; Exodus 34:14; Deuteronomy 32:4; Isaiah 6:3; Ecclesiastes 3:17; Malachi 3:6; Isaiah 45:5; Titus 2:13)
- How has he shown that He was the Incarnate Word?
 - The Meaning of _____ - John wrote that the Word became flesh (John 1:14). He also wrote of Jesus coming in the flesh (1 John 4:2; 2 John 7).
 - By this he meant that the eternal second Person of the Trinity took on Himself humanity. He did not possess humanity until the birth, since the Lord became flesh. However, His humanity was sinless, a fact that Paul guards by writing that He came “in the likeness of sinful flesh” (Romans 8:3).
 - The Predictions and Fulfillments of the _____ - Would be the “Seed of a Woman” – Prediction: (Genesis 3:15). Fulfillment: (Galatians 4:4; Luke 2:7; Revelation 12:5).
 - The Heir to the Throne of David – Prediction: (Isaiah 9:7). Fulfillment: (Matt. 1:1, 6).
 - Place of Birth – Prediction: (Micah 5:2). Fulfillment: (Matt.2:1; Luke 2:4-7)
 - Born of a Virgin – Prediction: (Isaiah 7:14). Fulfillment: (Matt. 1:18; Luke 1:26-35)
 - The _____ of the Incarnation Why did God send His Son in the likeness of sinful flesh? The Scriptures give several answers to that question.
 - ~ To Reveal God to Us

- ~ To Provide an Example for Our Lives: (1 Peter 2:21; 1 John 2:6).
- ~ To Provide an Effective Sacrifice for Sin: (Heb. 10:1-10).
- ~ To Be Able to Fulfill the Davidic Covenant: (Luke 1:31-33).
- ~ To Destroy the Works of the Devil: (1 John 3:8)
- ~ To Be Able to Be a Sympathetic High Priest: (Hebrews 4:14-16)
- ~ To Be Able to Be a Qualified Judge: (John 5:22, 27).
- The _____ of Christ Incarnate - The Full Deity of Christ Incarnate
 - ~ He Possesses Attributes Which Only God Has
 - ↳ Eternality – (John 8:58; 17:5)
 - ↳ Omnipresence – (Matthew 18:20; 28:20).
 - ↳ Omniscience – (Matt. 16:21; Luke 6:8; 11:17; John 4:29).
 - ↳ Omnipotence – (Matt. 28:18; Mark 5:11-15; John 11:38-44).
 - ~ He Performs Works Which Only God Can Do
 - ↳ Forgiveness – (Mark 2:1-12)
 - ↳ Life – (John 5:21)
 - ↳ Resurrection – (John 11:43)
 - ↳ Judgment – (John 5:22, 27)
 - ~ He Was Given the Names and Titles of Deity
 - ↳ Son of God
 - ↳ Lord and God – (Luke 1:76 with Mal. 3:1 and Rom. 10:13 with Joel 2:32). He is also called God (John 1:1; 20:28; Heb. 1:8), Lord (Matt. 22:43-45), and King of kings and Lord of lords (Rev. 19:16).
 - ↳ He Claimed to Be God - (John 10:30, v. 33).
- The Perfect _____ of Christ Incarnate
 - ~ He Had a Human Body – (Luke 2:52; John 8:40).
 - ~ He Had a Human Soul and Spirit – (Matt. 26:38; Luke 23:46).
 - ~ He Exhibited the Characteristics of a Human Being
 - ↳ He was hungry (Matt. 4:4)
 - ↳ He was thirsty (John 19:28)
 - ↳ He grew weary (John 4:6)
 - ↳ He experienced love and compassion (Matt. 9:36)
 - ↳ He wept (John 11:35)
 - ↳ He was tested (Heb. 4:15)
 - ↳ These are characteristics of true humanity
 - ~ He Was Called by Human Names
 - ↳ His favorite name for Himself was “Son of Man” (over eighty times) (Matt. 8:20; Luke 19:10; Matt. 24:27).
 - ↳ He was also the Son of David, a title that linked Him to His ancestor David and to the royal promises to be fulfilled ultimately by Messiah.
- Our _____ is to get to know Him by getting to know the Scriptures and the Savior.
