What is a Healthy Church Member?

Acts 2:41-47

A good church member is _____ because of a choice they made to follow Christ

- **_____ Saved**

- The healthy church member – the true church member – must know the work of God's grace personally.
 - “For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God” (Romans 3:23).
 - “But the scripture hath concluded all under sin” (Galatians 3:22a)
 - “Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned” (Romans 5:12).
 - ~ At his root, his core, his heart, man is _____ from and _____ toward God (Eph. 2:1-3).
- Sin Has To Be _____ For.
 - “For the wages of sin [is] death” (Romans 6:23).
 - “Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth (violates) also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law” (1 John 3:4).
 - “Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster [to bring us] unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith” (Galatians 3:24).
 - “Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God. Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law [is] the knowledge of sin” (Romans 3:19-20).
- What is the result of rejecting Him? The _____ of _____
 - “But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death” (Rev. 21:8).
- You can _____ to believe that Jesus Christ is Son of God who paid the penalty for your sins (Romans 10:9-10, 13)
 - “And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ ... as he gave us commandment.”
 - It's _____ from your sins and turning to _____ in Christ.
- How do we know that we are genuinely saved?
 - This is a self-examination which is a spiritually healthy thing to do (2 Cor. 13:5; Phil. 2:12; 2 Pet. 1:5-11).
 - Are we trusting in the finished work of Christ alone for our salvation? Is there evidence of God's grace in our lives? Are we growing in the grace and knowledge of Jesus Christ, in the fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-24), and in the virtues mentioned in Christ's beatitudes (Matt. 5:3-12)?
- Do we walk in the _____ or the _____?
 - If you are genuinely saved, then sin will convict the heart of a believer and grieve the Spirit of God (1 John 1:6-7)
 - A person who habitually and unrepentantly living in sin and denies that they are sinners (vv. 8-10), is probably not genuinely saved (1 John 3:5).
- Do we love _____ the Father?
 - There is no way to love both the world and the Father. And there is no way to embrace Christ without embracing the Father, or to come to the Father without believing on Christ. Love for God the Father is a test of genuine conversion. (1 John 2:15; 22-23).
- Do we love other _____?
 - Do we love what God loves (1 John 5:1)?
 - John teaches that the commandment is to believe in the name of Jesus Christ and to love one another (1 John 3:14b-15; 18-19).
- Do we have the _____ of the Spirit that we are children of God?

- The Father has not left us without a testimony of his love. We may be assured of our adoption into his family by God himself, the Holy Spirit assuring us (1 John 3:24b; Gal. 4:6; Rom. 8:15-16; 1 John 4:13-14).
- Are we _____ in the faith?
 - Those who believe and continue to believe are those who overcome the world by faith in Christ. Genuine faith is a persevering faith (1 John 5:4-5; Eph. 1:13-14; 1 Peter 1:3-5).
- Do you know for sure that heaven is your home?
