Eph. 1:15-23

When the church prays for one another, she taps into her powerful and spiritual resource – the _____.

A Blueprint for us to know today – we should know more about Christ because of the impact from _____ and His _____!

- **Impact of the _____ of Christ**
 - Wisdom according to Webster’s 1828 dictionary means the right use or exercise of _____.
 - Revelation means laying bare, making naked; a _____ of truth, instruction; manifestation, appearance.
 - A person can only be known through a _____ of revelation that is going to reveal some facts about them
 - He has revealed Himself to us two ways – the _____ Word and the _____ Word.
- **Impact of the _____ of Christ (v. 18)**
 - “minds” would understand “their way of thinking” the truths of God’s Word.
 - “enlightened” which means to shine a light
 - The invitation we had from Him to be saved will only stand if we accept the call by _____ and _____!
 - The only explanation of His amazing, divine love – is a love that has its own reason and logic that is beyond our understanding.
 - ~ The fact of His inheritance is in the saints, because it is not in the sinner.
 - ~ The fame of His inheritance is the glory of it.
 - ~ The fullness of His inheritance is the riches of the glory.
 - ~ We are assets of incredible worth to the living God because of the precious _____ of His dear Son!
 - Thank you Father that our hope is in you and it is secure and that our inheritance gives us value because of the precious blood of your Son!
- **Impact of the _____ of Christ (vv. 19-21)**
 - We have all the power of God who sits on the throne of Heaven directed toward us!
 - The word power means strength or power put forth with effect.
 - The word might mean strength as an endowment.
 - The word working means strength put forth or energy.
 - Think about it – God made an enormous expenditure of His strength, power, and energy in the work of the cross and the resurrection of His Son from the grave to redeem us from sin!
 - Raising Jesus from the dead was the demonstration of God’s power.
 - The same power that God raised Jesus from the grave is the same power that _____ in and wants to work through us.
 - Where is Jesus seated now? He is seated at the right hand of the Father. And all principalities and powers are under his feet.

- The Lord Jesus is enthroned far above _____ spiritual seats of power.
- This also means that whatever form of government there are and whatever the names or titles of those in power may be, all are subject to Christ. He reigns on high and overrules them all.
- He is over all things that includes His church, the bride!
- Members of the true church find their fullness in their _____ to the head.
 - There is reason why we need God’s power. There are enemies who want to rob us of our wealth (Eph. 1:21; 6:11–12). We could never defeat these spiritual foes in our own power, but we can through the Spirit’s power.
- **Application**
 - But how does this apply to you and me today?
 - Because we are believers, we are in the church, which is Christ’s body—and He is the Head. This means that there is a living connection between you and Christ. Physically speaking, the head controls the body and keeps the body functioning properly. Injure certain parts of the brain and you handicap or paralyze corresponding parts of the body. Christ is our spiritual Head. Through the Spirit, we are united to Him as the members of His body. This means that we share His resurrection, ascension, and exaltation.
 - No wonder Paul wants us to know “the exceeding greatness of His power to us-ward”! Apart from this power, we cannot draw on our great wealth in Christ.¹ The power of the Holy Spirit, through the resurrected, ascended Christ, is available to all Christians—by faith. His power is to “us-ward who believe” (Eph. 1:19). It supplies the wealth, but it is faith that lays hold of the wealth. We are saved “by grace, through faith” (Eph. 2:8–9), and we live “by grace,” through faith (1 Cor. 15:10).
 - Will you, starting today, begin to know by experiencing God—God’s calling—God’s riches—and God’s power?² It will take complete _____ of your life to His will!
- **Conclusion**
 - The impact of knowing who Jesus is, what you have in Him, and how He can work in and through you comes from _____ and His _____!
