## What is a Healthy Church Member?

Acts 2:41-47

A good church member is \_\_\_\_\_ because of a choice they made to follow Christ.

- \_\_\_\_\_ **and** \_\_\_\_\_ **Membership**
  - “Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added [unto them] about three thousand souls. And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.” (Acts 2:41-42)
  - Baptism Requires the Proper \_\_\_\_\_
    - Biblically speaking, baptism is always of believers (Acts 2:41).
    - The clearest example of an individual's baptism in the Bible is the Ethiopian eunuch found Acts 8:36-39.
  - Baptism Requires the Proper \_\_\_\_\_
    - Do we immerse, sprinkle, or pour? You can study the entire Bible and never will you find any other method of baptism except by immersion.
    - The word baptism literally means “to dip, to plunge, to submerge, or to immerse.” (Acts 8:38-39; Matthew 3:16)
    - Baptism is a demonstration of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
  - Baptism Requires the Proper \_\_\_\_\_ which was given to the local church by our Lord Jesus Christ.
    - The responsibility of administering baptism was given to the local church by our Lord Jesus Christ.
    - Ordinances are pictures or object lessons that teach \_\_\_\_\_ (Matt. 28:19-20; 1 Cor. 11:2).
      - ~ Our administration of these ordinances teaches either right doctrine or false doctrine.
      - ~ The ordinances are local church ordinances; that is, they have been given to the local New Testament church, not an individual person, and as such are administered by the pastor or a pastor of the local church as overseer of that church.
  - Three Key Words Explain Baptism
    - \_\_\_\_\_ to the command of the Lord Jesus Christ (Matt. 28:19-20a).
      - ~ Jesus said, “If he love me, keep my commandments.” (John 14:15) Baptism should be one of the very first acts of obedience to the Lord Jesus Christ.
      - ~ Examples from Scripture of people who were saved, and then after salvation (and only after), were baptized in water: the Ethiopian eunuch (Acts 8:37-38), Cornelius (Acts 10:44-48), the Apostle Paul (Acts 9:1-19), the Philippian jailor (Acts 16:30-31), Lydia (Acts 16:14-15), Crispus, and many Corinthians (Acts 18:8).
    - \_\_\_\_\_ with Jesus Christ, a body of doctrine, and a local church.
      - ~ The Bible gives us several examples of the identifying nature of baptism.
        - The Holy Spirit identified with Christ at His baptism (Mark 1:10).
        - The Father identified with Christ as His baptism, “Thou art my beloved Son in whom I am well pleased” (Mark 1:11).

- Christ also identified with us at His baptism foretelling his death, burial, and resurrection for the remission of our sins.
- ~ In baptism we identify with a body of doctrine.
  - Why did Jesus request baptism from John the Baptist? After all, John's baptism was "the baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins" (Mark 1:4; John 1:15, 27). John was calling people back to Messianic Judaism. He was telling them to look for the coming Messiah. Jesus identified with this message, affirming it through His baptism.
- ~ In baptism we identify with a local church and that church's doctrine. (Read Acts 2:41-42).
  - The door to church membership is baptism. We are baptized by the Holy Spirit into Christ as salvation (1 Cor. 12:13). This awesome event is testified of and pictured in our baptism by water into His only physical, visible body on earth, the local church.
  - Baptism is the physical picture of the spiritual reality. If a person is saved and then baptized in a church that doesn't believe in the eternal security of the believer, that person had identified through their baptism with conditional salvation.

- \_\_\_\_\_ to Christ and His purposes for the believer's life.
  - ~ Baptism also demonstrates submission to the local church and its authority in his life (Heb. 13:17; 1 Peter 5:5).
- Recap of the significant Baptism:
  - It is significant because it's a picture of the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ (Rom. 6:3-5).
  - It's a picture of new life (2 Cor. 5:17).
  - It's a picture of obedience. The message of Scripture is clear: "Repent, and be baptized" (Acts 2:38).
  - It is a picture of forgiveness.
  - It is a picture of identification with Christ.
